Public Health & Medical

Strategic Planning Oversight Team

- Strategic priorities
- Cooperative Agreement, Advisory Board requirement
- Output: Strategic Priorities for Preparedness Activities

Funding Advisory Board

- Determines percentage based allocations
- Output: Funding Allocation Methodology

Funded Entities

- Build capabilities
- Output: Inputs for narrative and work plan

Cooperative Agreement Workplan

- Provides federal guidance on public health and medical preparedness (one input)
- Output: Approved narrative and work plan

Healthcare Coalition Preparedness

- Establish an organizational structure
- Expand your membership
- Determine risks
- Develop work plans
- Implement work plans
- Monitor, evaluate, repeat



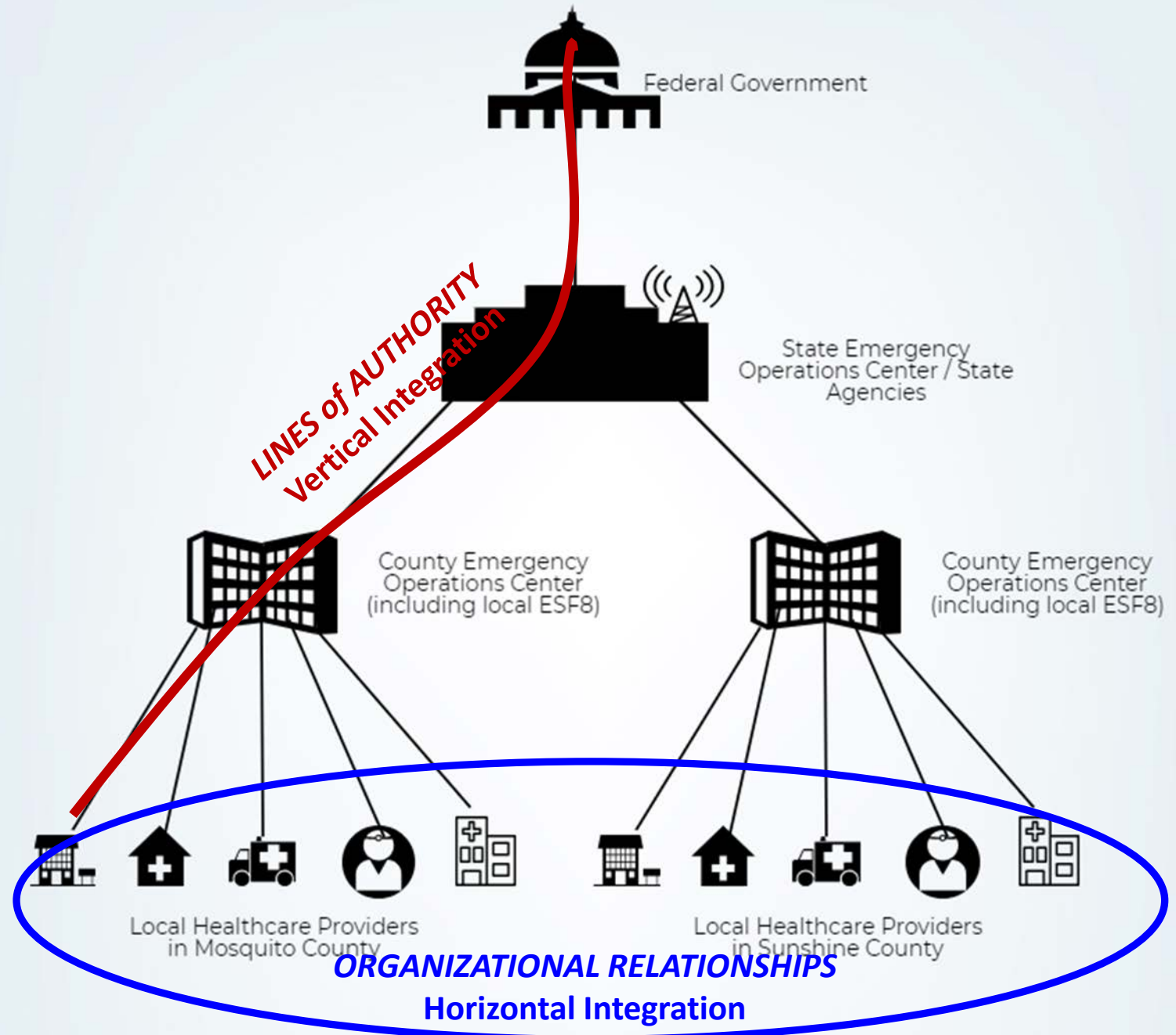
Healthcare Coalition Response (Requirements)

- Serve a communication and coordination role within their respective jurisdictions
- Ensures the integration of health care delivery into the broader community's incident planning objectives and strategy development
- Ensures that resource needs that cannot be managed within the HCC itself are rapidly passed along to the ESF-8 lead agency
- Coordination may occur at its own coordination center, the local EOC, or by virtual means – all of which are intended to interface with the ESF-8 lead agency. Coordination between the HCC and the ESF-8 lead agency can occur in a number of ways.
- Define and share essential elements of information (EEl)s to include elements of electronic health record and resource needs and availability.



Relationships

- Implementation of the model using established emergency management structure
- Overlays contractual requirements



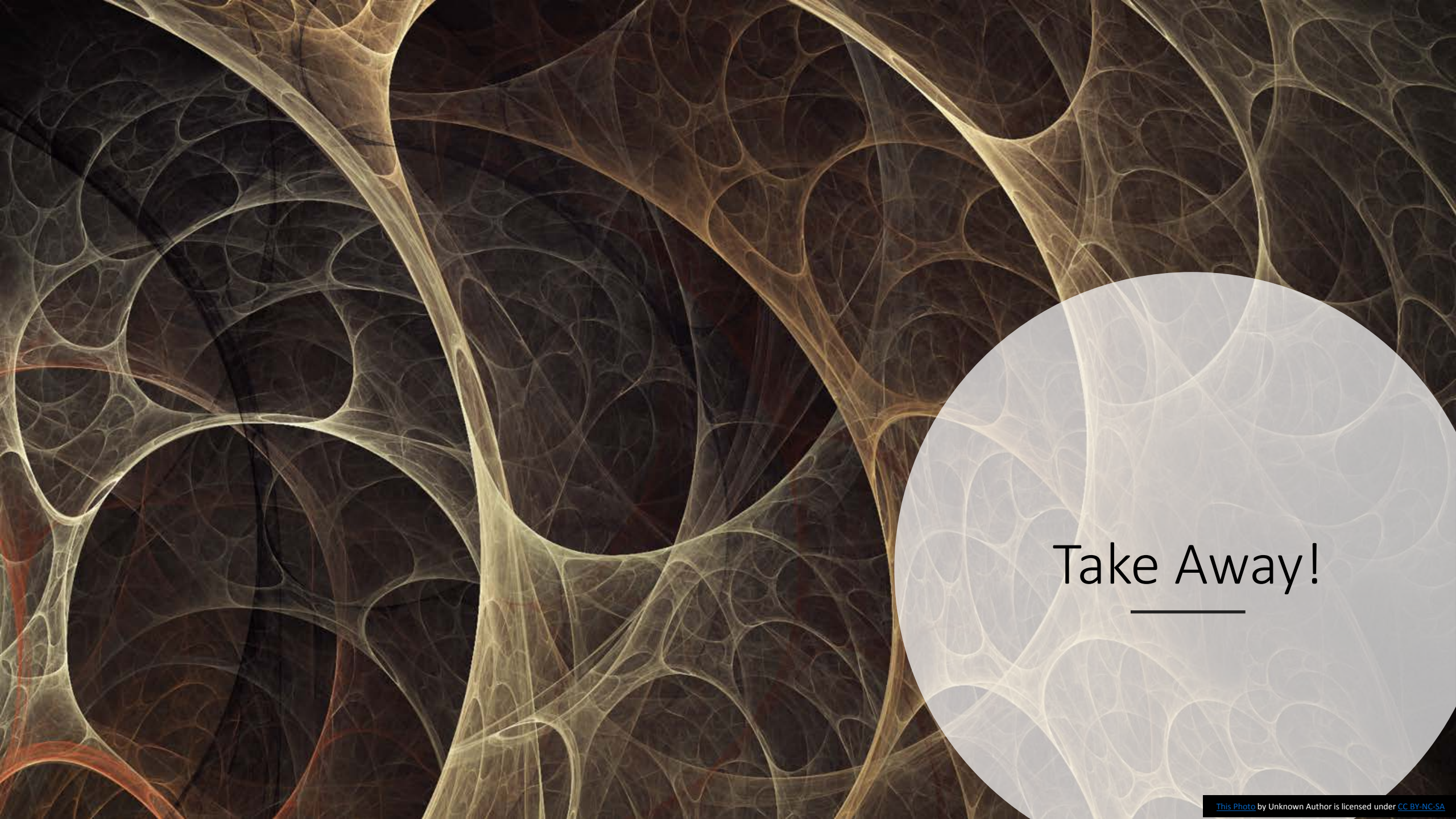
State ESF8 Updates
