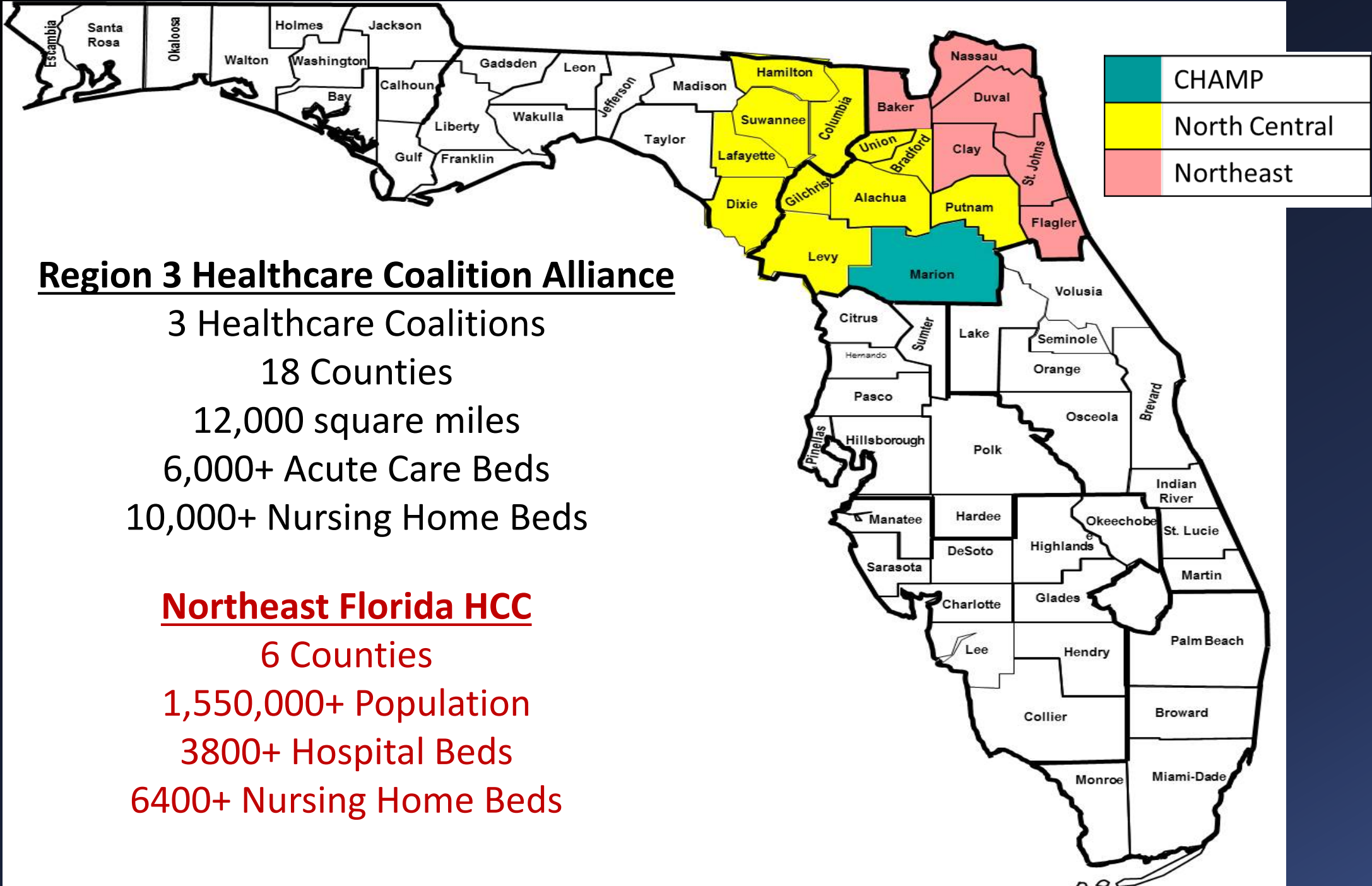

- 10,000+ Nursing Home Beds

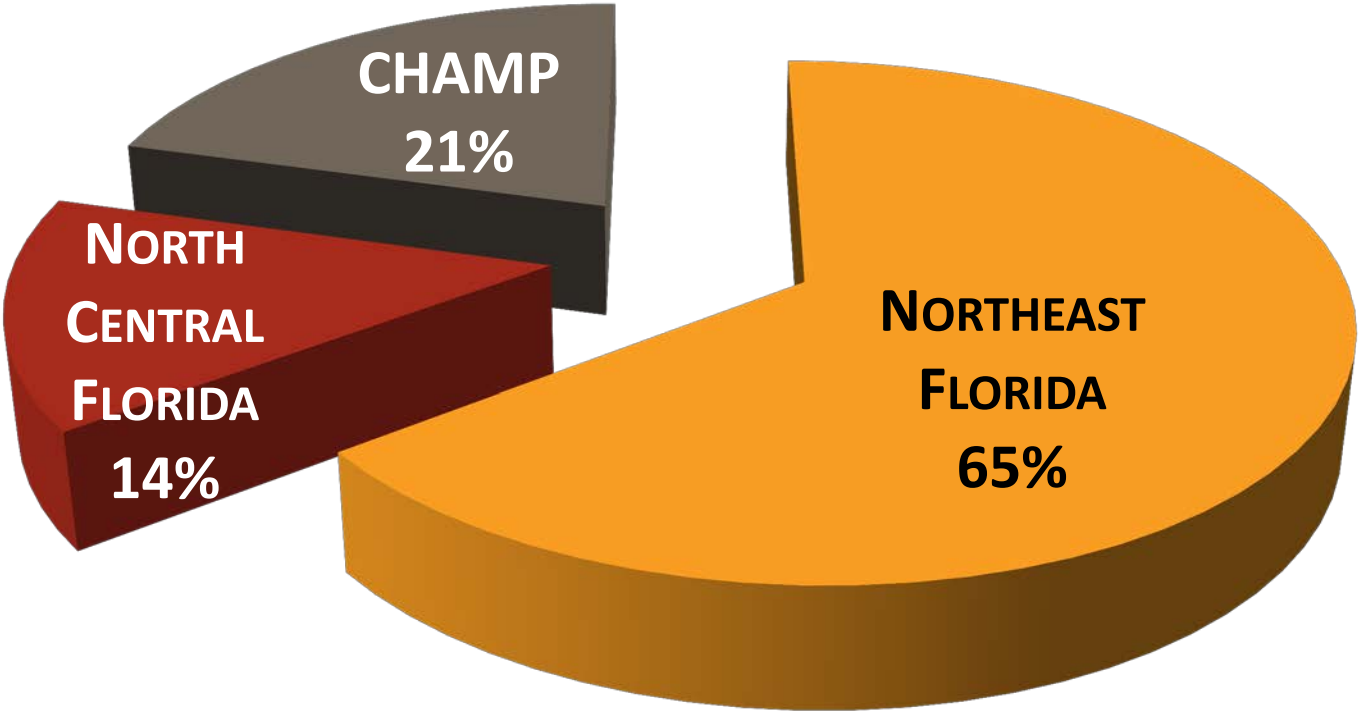

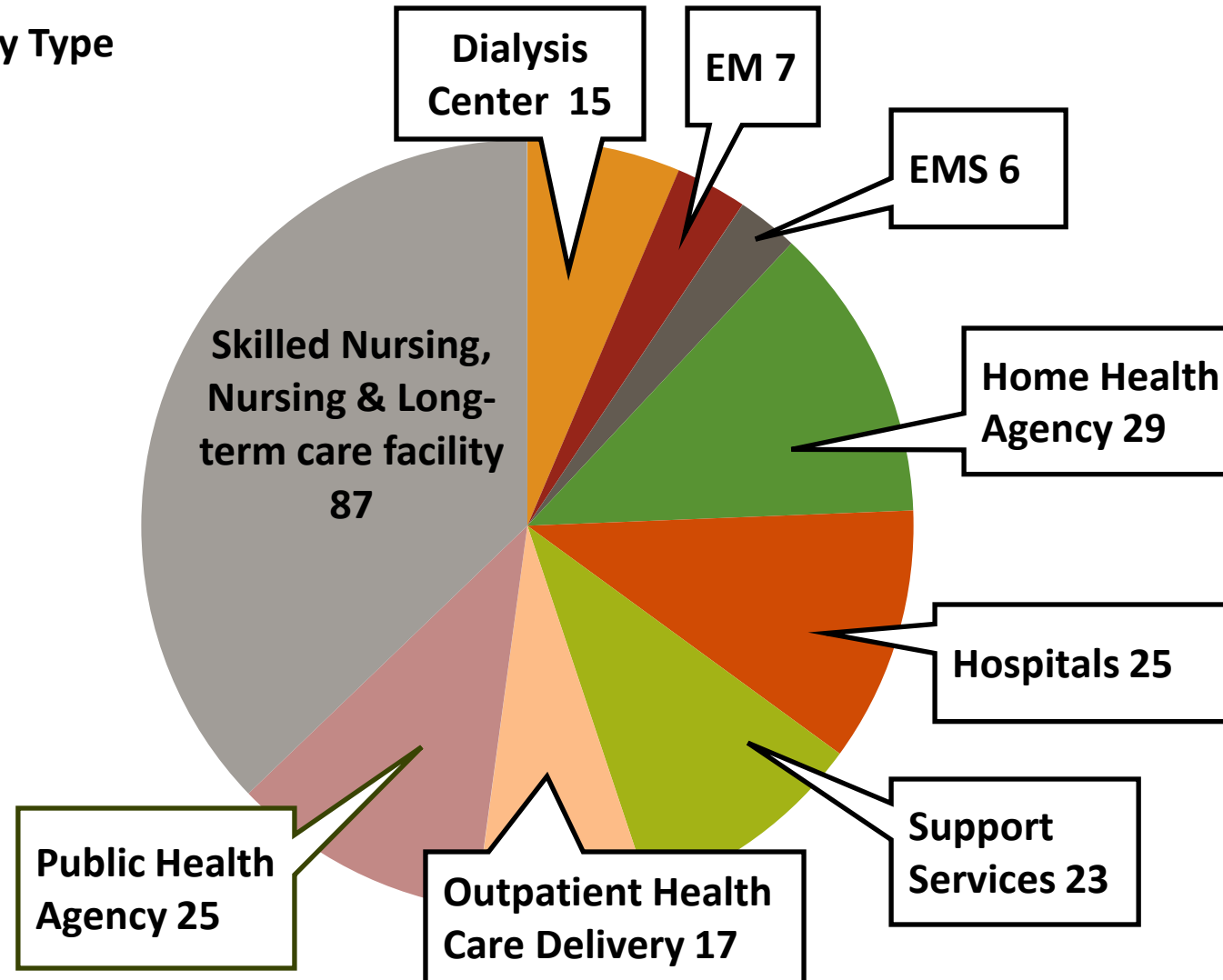
Region 3 Coalitions Membership

Training and Exercise Program

Coalition Surge Tool Exercise

The Coalitions sponsored the first CST Exercise in March. All facilities successfully completed the objectives and the HCCs gained insight into its role in situational awareness for these types of events.

- 3 hospitals evacuated
- 125 total participants

CMS Exercises

The Coalitions sponsored tabletop exercises for members to assist them in meeting the new CMS Rule requirements.

- 6 Table Top Exercises
- 233 members participated

Stop the Bleed Program

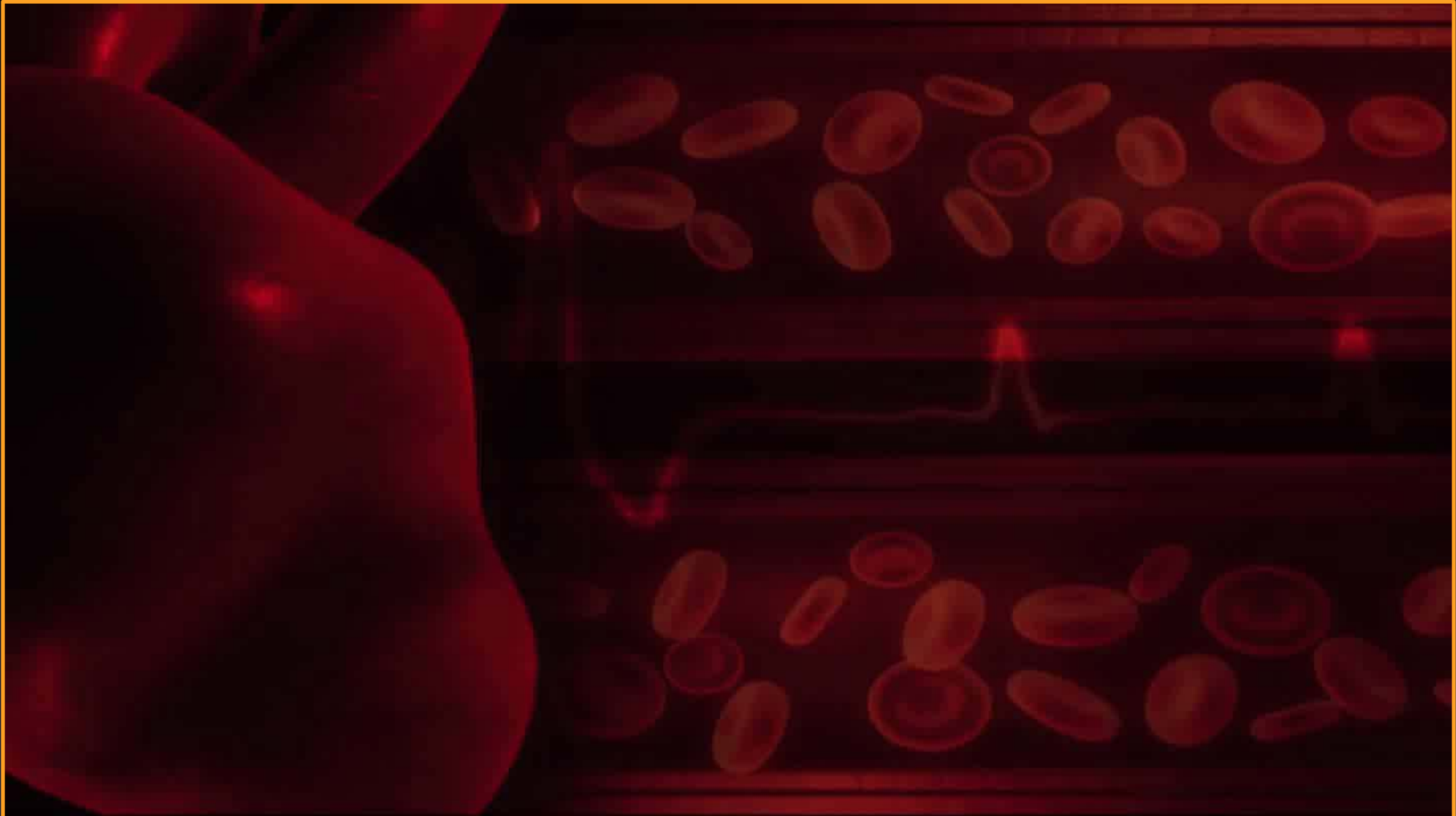


- **Stop the Bleed** campaign aims to raise awareness of life saving strategies and provide public access to bleeding control tools.
- Healthcare Coalitions in Region 3, through NEFRC, purchased **3,000 kits** in partnership with school districts across 18 counties to place in schools.

- Partnership with Trauma Centers to provide training.
- Additional **1,200 kits** purchased were distributed to counties for their use (+/- 60 per county).
