

## Statewide Conference Call Summaries from Monday, April 13, 2020

Over the weekend, MQA sent an email to licensed practitioners to notify them of three important issues. This email went to the email on file with the licensure office.

- 1. There is a new resource pool for unemployed healthcare workers. This allows MQA to link facilities that need workers and those recently unemployed healthcare workers needing work.
- 2. MQA has also created a process for reactivation of licensure for retired providers. This process went live on Saturday and is short-term, only for COVID response.
- 3. MQA and FDOH requests providers that are not providing services during this response to donate PPE to the county EOC, testing sites, or long-term care facilities.

ESS released new fields over the weekend along with additional instructions to complete these fields. The intent is to capture greater detail for surge capacity for staffed and non-staffed beds. Those that enter data should communicate with the executive leadership at hospitals to ensure accuracy.

AHCA is adding the appropriate fields so that the ESS data will meet the requirements for the Federal data required of all hospitals. AHCA may need to add a few more fields, but this will allow for single entry of data for hospitals. Thank you for your patience as AHCA works to make reporting easier for hospitals.

There continues to be questions concerning testing for hospital transfers to long-term care facilities. All hospitals work with the county health departments to send test samples for hospitalized patients that meet CDC criteria to the FDOH state labs. Contact county health departments to complete this process.

FDOH has been working to procure swab kits. Some have been received but are waiting on validation before they will be sent out. For those that were sent out, facilities should wait until FDA approves the validation of these kits.

There continues to be questions about the transfer of behavioral health patients to the State hospital. AHCA is working with DCF to find the appropriate resource to assist with these issues for placement of court-ordered placements.

Hospitals that need to have the Alternate Care Site plans approved by the state should send the plan to the hospital licensing unit for approval. Please note that it is an ACS approval request.

There was also more discussion about the serology tests that are on the market. While there is one with FDA EUA approval, serology tests are NOT approved for diagnostic purposes.

The FHA-Hospital calls will now only be held on Monday and Friday at 10:00 am.

EMS should use masks on all patients, even if not presenting with COVID.

There are more than 250 long-term care facilities statewide that have COVID + staff members. Regional teams are being set-up to assist with this issue.

It seems that providing better oxygenation for patients provides for a better outcome that early intubation and early ventilator use for many patients.

The region will continue to see increased rain and the potential for severe weather throughout the week. Follow local forecasts.
