Applications must describe the projects alignments with the (HPP) and meet one of the four Health Care Preparedness & Response Capabilities. Preference given to Regional projects and applications that align with specialty surge events. Staff asked members to use the fillable pdf document and not print and scan the forms.

three virtual tabletop exercises recently. Each exercise had about 20 participants. After July 1, more training will be offered, with virtual options.

MRSE Exercise – June 23 (partnering with FCDC)

Staff report the MRSE exercise is an opportunity for members to participate in dealing with a surge event scenario and how the region would deal with the surge. More information to come.
