The conference was well attended and there were many valuable learning opportunities. Staff met with the ASPR program leads and learned about the changes coming to the ASPR program/HPP capabilities.

HVA Updates

The Region 3 Healthcare HVA annual update has begun. Staff will send the document out for review and comment. As part of the update process, staff is developing some project ideas to fill

gaps in the medical surge specialty areas: Pediatric, Burn, Radiation, Chemical and Infectious Disease response. Surveys will be sent soon to begin this process.

FIDTN Exercise
